




Q2 In general, have you found the prompt desks and seating provided well designed, comfortable and well positioned for operating without muscle strain or stretching?





Q3 In your experience at work in recent years has the prompt desk mostly been





Q4 Thinking about a typical recent show how did you mostly view and follow the show on stage ?





Q5 Have you ever found operating a prompt desk uncomfortable?





Q6 Have you found that you need to stretch or half stand on your chair or twist your body to operate desks successfully and effectively?











Q10 Thinking about shows in the past two years how many times have the cameras and monitors been good quality and positioned correctly?





Q11 Have you ever experienced back or muscle pain or repetitive strain after operating shows at a prompt desk?





Q12 Have you ever visited a health care specialist as a result of back or muscle pain caused by your work?





Q13 Have you ever had time off work as a result of back pain or muscle strains?





Q14 Would you attribute any of these times off work to be as a result of operating a prompt desk?





Q15 Has a theatre company or arts employer ever paid for treatments for back pain/muscle pain/strains during or as a result of working on a show?







Q17 In your experience are the desks and chairs in prompt corners generally as well designed specified and positioned as work stations in modern offices you have worked in?




